



## CITIZEN'S SUMMARY

**Annual Implementation Report 2020** 



A citizen's summary of the contents of the Annual Report has been made public and uploaded as an annex to the Annual Implementation Report. The Annual Report 2020 of the Interreg V-A Slovakia-Austria Cooperation Programme has been prepared pursuant to Annex X of Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2015/207. The report is intended to give an overview of the activities that were undertaken in the frame of the programming process, focusing on the year 2020. Regarding its structure, the Interreg V-A SK-AT cooperation programme addresses five investment priorities (IP) under four priority axes (PA). In addition, a fifth priority axis on technical assistance has been introduced.

This summary is report of Interreg V-A SK-AT activities in 2020. It presents key points and highlights from the year.



# NemoNet Network Integrative Quality Tourism in the Neusiedler See - Modra region

The project was engaged in the joint development and improvement of inclusive quality tourism offerings, as well as green transportation possibilities, which are both suistainable.

The fields of interest are ecomobility (development infrastructure e-mobility), water management (revitalization of natural ponds in Modra and Purbach), and culture (history of the Germanspeaking forest workers - Huncokari - in Modra).

Know-how transfers on bird habitats, nature conservation and sustainable tourism as well as water management round off the project, creating cross-border synergies.

Through the project, model nodes and stepping stones were built directly, representing oases for butterflies, insects and biodiversity in an intensively used landscape.

General workshops provided knowledge that could be used directly in your own garden or in the schoolyard by creating your own little stepping stones through the use of butterfly packages.

Schools, cities, municipalities, citizens, gardeners and media partners in SK and AT worked together on a solution in a cross-border project and at the same time form the basis for future projects on biodiversity.

### COMMUNICATION

The MA/JS continuously informed the target groups about the stages of the implementation, provided useful information, downloadable documents and project news via the programme website (www.sk-at.eu) and through Facebook. In addition, Keep database (www.keep.eu) with project information has been regularly updated.

All communication activities were affected by the restrictions of Covid-19 pandemic situation, therefore the MA/JS prepared online seminars and cosultations via Webex, MS Teams, Zoom, etc.

In order to support the effective implementation of projects and of the Cooperation programme, the MA in close cooperation with JS organized online "Lead beneficiary and partner seminar" on 24th September 2020 from Vienna.





In addition, so-called "Open days" (consultations with applicants) were organized by the JS at 7 different dates during 2020 corresponding to particular assessment rounds of CfP – 4th February in Bratislava, 11th February in Vienna, 21st September and 6th October in Vienna and 8th October 2020 in online form in Bratislava and subsequently in full online mode (due to the deteriorating pandemic situation with COVID-19) on 11th and 19th November 2020.

The regular "Annual Event of the Programme" did not take place in 2020, due to the ongoing pandemic situation and the travel restrictions.
